- This motion and order shall be served on the judgment debtor by personal service, unless otherwise authorized by law in §801.14(1)(2), Wisconsin Statutes.
- The judgment debtor may avoid appearing at this hearing only by, prior to the hearing date, either**
 - paying the judgment in full, including costs and accrued interest, or
 - delivering an accurate and complete Financial Disclosure Statement to the judgment creditor.
- If the judgment creditor does not appear at this hearing, this motion may be dismissed.
 - **A finding of contempt for nonappearance or failure to comply with the court's order may result in any or all of the following penalties:**
 - Imprisonment for up to **6 months**.
 - Forfeiture of not more than **\$2000 per day**.
 - Any other order necessary to ensure your compliance.
